When offered a position as Asst. Professor of Management at CMU, Carlos jumped at the opportunity move to Grand Junction.

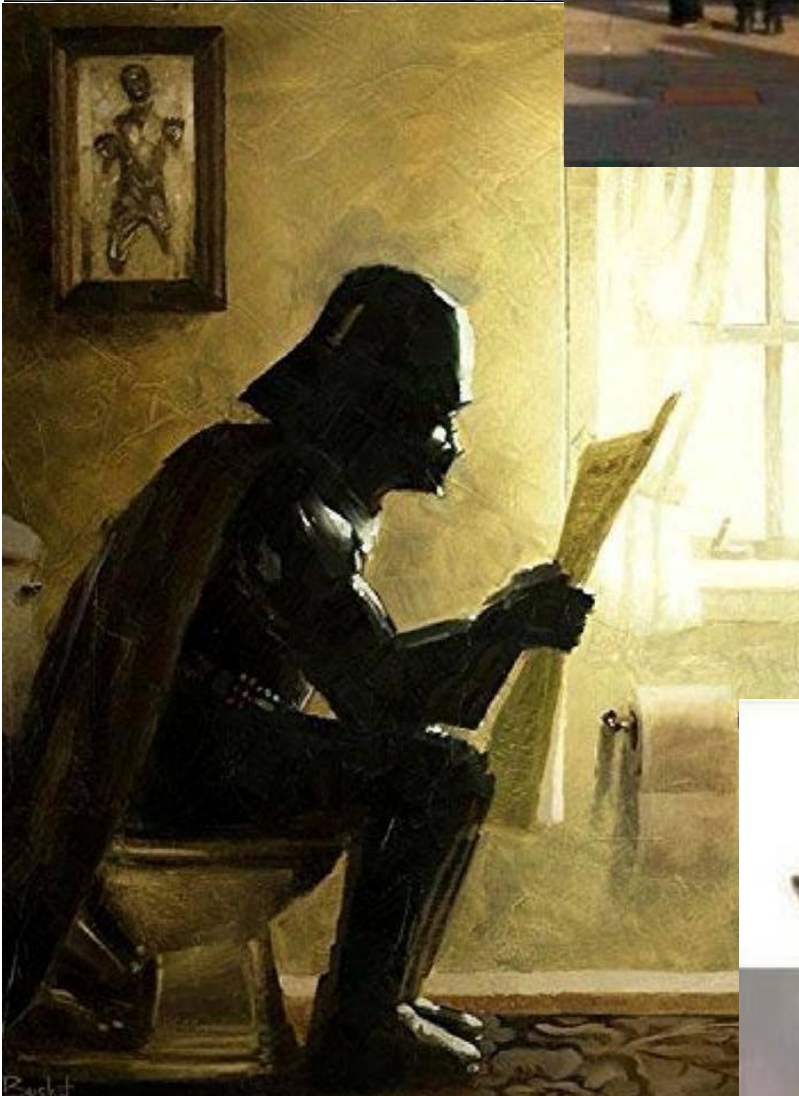
Once settled in GJ, Carlos joined the club in October, 2017.
